Task 1 Guidance (P1, D1)

P1 - Assume that the Owner is competent in using spreadsheets for normal calculations and purposes but has never set up a spreadsheet with more than one worksheet and has no experience of using more complex functions.

You will need to explain how spreadsheets can be used to solve complex problems, and you should provide examples to support your explanation.

What to cover:
